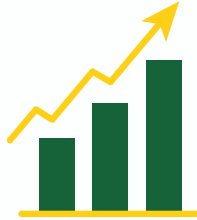


## Empowering Vermont's Workforce

More than **2,600** adult career & tech ed students have earned industry certifications upon completion of their program in the last 3 years.

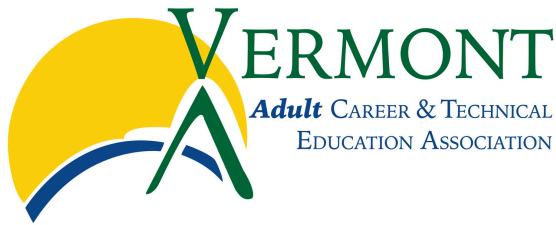


### ■ Historically Underrepresented
