Financial Aid, the FAFSA, and other Financing Opportunities

- Vermont Guarantee is a partnership agreement between the Community College of Vermont (CCV) and participating colleges and universities in Vermont. Students interested in transferring to a participating institution can now take advantage of this option for a seamless transfer of credits. Learn more at www.ccv.edu:
 - **Key features include**; no application fee, guaranteed admission, guaranteed transfer of credits, junior status upon enrollment, and scholarships and incentives (vary by receiving college)
- The U.S. Department of Education's Office of Federal Student Aid (FSA) will launch the 2025-26 FAFSA through a new process starting October 1, with initial testing involving a limited group of students and institutions. This phased rollout is designed to identify and address any system issues, with more details on the testing process to come. The application will be fully accessible for all applicants by December 1, 2024.

- Now is the time for your student to get started if they're interested in Dual Enrollment or Early College. Encourage your student to check in with their OC about getting started.
